

Revert from Static IP to DHCP Mode



Applicable: WEM-MX, WEPM, WEM-IO models.

General: In most deployments, the device is configured to use a static IP Address. When a network's gateway or subnet is changed, you cannot get access the WEPM or WEM-MX using the preset IP address. Therefore, a means has been provided to revert back to DHCP mode.

Steps:

1. Power down the device. Note: When you remove the power plug, the device will automatically switch to battery backup. You will have to wait 6 minutes for the device to shutdown. If that does not occur, unplug the lithium ion battery.
2. Locate the 2 X 4 header and short the DHCP connections.



3. You can use the Discover IP application to identify the new IP address when the device reboots using DHCP.
4. Power up the device and remember to connect the battery.
5. Note: This process will take around 5 minutes.
6. Lastly, remove the jumper / shorting block.
